2023 Annual Meeting

Hartford Federal Credit Union's (HFCU) 62nd Annual Meeting was held on April 23, 2024, at the University of St. Joseph. Credit Union officers were proud to report that the Credit Union had the second most profitable year in its 63-year history while donating more to charitable causes than ever before!

HFCU ended 2023 with total assets of \$149 million and a capital ratio of 11.86 percent, nearly 70 percent above our federal regulator's definition of a wellcapitalized credit union.

Directors Honored


During the Annual Meeting, two members of our Board of Directors were recognized for their dedication to HFCU.
